***TAFTA** and *Dragon Design* are seeking images from artists/designers across Australia and New Zealand for publication in late 2010 of a juried collection showcasing fibre/textile objects created since 2000. All entries will be screened by *Dragon Design*, in the first instance, for technical quality of images and adherence to the competition rules, and payment of entry fees (if applicable). Images will then be transferred to DVD and sent to a panel of qualified judges (to be confirmed) for final selection.

Fibre and textiles must be the main focus of all work, but choose work that reflects the book's concept for its 150 pages of *Fibre Design*. See Categories on front of flyer.
